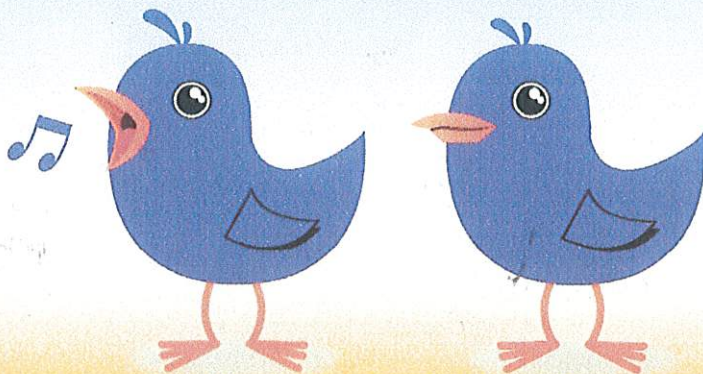


New Voice Choir
